17TO RECEIVE THE FIRST DRAFT OF THE NEW PLAN FOR THE JUNCTION20/21OF MARKET STREET AND SOUTH STREET AND CONSIDER COMMENTSFOR HIGHWAYS

Councillors agreed that the proposed new road layout appeared, on balance, to offer an improvement. However, they expressed concern that the new layout might be more dangerous from the point of view of pedestrians crossing the road at this junction. The Deputy Clerk was asked to relay this feedback to Highways.

18 TO RECEIVE ANY OTHER MATTERS OF REPORT

20/21

Cllr. Hartshorn raised the following points:

- A "Give Way" sign had appeared at the bottom of Barn Street, which gave the impression that drivers could turn right into West Street. The Deputy Clerk was asked to contact Highways to investigate.
- Cllr. Hartshorn reminded Councillors that, when they had recently discussed transfer of ownership from SSDC of the "ski slope" land in front of the Town Hall, they had agreed to include the SSDC car parking spaces. He asked for clarification that the parking spaces included not only those adjacent to the "ski slope", but also the car parking space to the east of the Town Hall. Councillors agreed that this was the case and asked the Clerk to ensure that the transfer application reflected this.
- Cllr. Hartshorn asked for clarification from SSDC of their plans for the installation of EV chargers in Crewkerne. Cllr. Pailthorpe responded by stating that SSDC were planning to install an EV charging point in the Lidl car park and to install EV charging points at the planned Millers Garage car park. In view of this, he recommended that the Town Council defer any consideration of installing EV chargers for the time being.
